Policy Statement

Christchurch Boys' High School is committed to providing and maintaining a safe and health working environment for its staff members, students, visitors, and all persons using the premises as a place of work or learning.

To ensure a safe and healthy work environment, a Health and Safety Management System or Plan will be operated and reviewed annually. The system will cover physical and emotional well-being.

The school will liaise and take appropriate steps in dealing with parents who are subject to a court order which doesn't allow them to have access to a child at the school.
