

# **INTERNATIONAL FEE PAYING STUDENTS POLICY**

## **Purpose**

Christchurch Boys' High School offers a limited number of places to international fee paying students who identify with the mission and vision of the school. The presence of international students enhances the opportunities and perspectives of all students. Having international students will provide

- Exposure to other cultures which will enable NZ resident students to better integrate and take a place in society
- The ability for international students to learn English in a caring environment
- Greater opportunities for all students to learn through additional financial benefits to the school

## **Policy Statement**

International fee-paying students receive an education consistent with that provided to domestic students.

The Board of Trustees sets a maximum number of international fee-paying students and fees for International students for the following year, prior to budgeting.

International students will be required to sign a contract establishing the terms and conditions that International students will be admitted to the school

The school will provide programs and pastoral guidance and support to meet the individual learning and social needs of the international fee paying students

The international student program will be evaluated annually to include

- Evaluation of the student results and course effectiveness
- Financial benefits to the school
