

# Year 13 Tourism Course Outline 2010

## Introduction

Tourism is a one year course leading to a National Certificate in Tourism (Introductory Skills) at Level 2. The course is designed and overseen by the Aviation, Tourism and Travel Training Organisation (ATTTO). The course is unit standards based and includes compulsory Tourism standards, elective Tourism standards chosen by the school and generic core compulsory standards that will be cross credited from Level 2 English and Level 1 Mathematics standards. It is your responsibility to make sure you have the required generic papers for the National Certificate in Tourism. The 12 Level Three credits may also be used towards University entrance. There may also be an option to also take part in a 'Kiwi Host' course during the year.

## Workbooks

Most of the work is done in student workbooks. Some of the assessments are open book tests and you may be able to use the manuals, with your completed work, in these tests. These are yours to keep after assessment and moderation are completed.

## Assessment

Assessment is by way of Common Assessment Tasks (CATs). These take various forms and include tests, projects and presentations. They may be open book or closed tests.

For Assessment Procedures and Policies see the CBHS Assessment Regulations. There will be one reassessment opportunity.

## Costs

There is a cost for your workbooks. As detailed in the course book, the cost to you is \$110. This means you own the workbook and after marking and moderation they are yours to keep. The full cost for these workbooks is \$235, the difference being subsidised through STAR funding.
