This year we study NCEA-1 Chinese. We have a set hanzi list of 370 Chinese characters and set grammar (NCEA-1 Grammar.)

There are 6 achievement standards for NCEA-1 Chinese. They are:

1	AS90072	Listen to and understand spoken language in Chinese in familiar contexts.	6 credits
2	AS90073	Give a prepared talk in Chinese on a familiar topic.	3 credits
3	AS90074	Converse in Chinese in a familiar context.	3 credits
4	AS90075	Read and understand written language in Chinese in familiar contexts.	6 credits
5	AS90076	Write text in Chinese on a familiar topic.	3 credits
6	AS90077	Write in Chinese on a familiar topic, with the support of resources.	3 credits

Numbers 1 (listening), 4 (reading), and 5 (writing) are to be assessed externally in a 3 hour examination in November.

Numbers 2 (a speech), 3 (conversation), and 6 (writing with resources) are internally assessed. The speech will all be assessed late in term 2 and the conversation and writing in Term 3. Retesting in Term 4 may take place for the speech and conversation, but there will be only one opportunity for writing with resources. Exact dates will depend on other activities in Term 3, but the order of the assessments will be: firstly the speech; secondly writing with resources, and thirdly the conversation.

Our textbook is :”Ni Hao 3” (with its workbook) .

It is important that all students are consistent in doing their homework and assignments. The daily learning and revising of hanzi is beneficial for all to do so.
