

YEAR 12 JAPANESE STUDENT HANDOUT

Aim

A course of study for NCEA Level Two Japanese should enable you, at the survival and social competence stage, to:

1. develop the skills needed to understand and use spoken and written Japanese.
2. communicate effectively in Japanese for authentic purposes
3. learn the conventions of communication in Japanese and develop an understanding of Japanese culture.

Objectives

By the end of the year, you will be able to

1. comprehend detail and summarize meaning in spoken and written Japanese.
2. initiate and maintain a conversation that may have some unpredictable content.
3. write extended passages, presenting ideas and information logically and demonstrating your expanding knowledge of kanji.
4. demonstrate your understanding of contemporary Japanese life and show an awareness of current attitude and values.

Homework

You will receive 30-45 minutes of homework each lesson.

After each lesson, please;

- a) read the pages you learned on the day (5 minutes)
- b) complete homework (mostly written work) (10-15 minutes)
- c) practice new words and kanji (10 minutes)
- d) revise sentences patterns (10 minutes)

Then, please;

- e) read 2-3 pages for the next lesson (5minutes)

By your doing these, you go over the textbooks three times which will help you to learn the language a great deal. Please try to develop this routine as soon as possible.

The prescription of the internal assessment activities will be given to you two weeks before each assessment for the speaking assessments and on the first session for the writing assessment.

Minimum requirement

You must complete all tests / assessments set in all the modes. Failure to complete any aspect of test or assessment on the due date will have serious consequence.

Due date for the assessment work

All work must be completed on time. When you fail to meet the deadlines, you must approach the teacher with a written reason for lateness from a parent / caregiver. Assessment not completed by the due date will receive a zero mark, unless the reason given is acceptable. You must complete assessment tasks that you have missed regardless of whether or not the assessment task is marked.

Moderation

The assessment tasks and your work will be sent to the moderator to be moderated.

Re-assessment

You may request a re-assessment under the following conditions.

- ✓ You have followed instructions in preparation for the original assessment.

And

- ✓ You have sat the original assessment on the day set.

And

- ✓ You did not meet the standard to gain credits or the grade you wish to gain.

When you wish to request a re-assessment, you must approach the teacher with a note with your parent's / caregiver's signature in the first week of term 4. Note that the assessment activity for the re-assessments will be different from the original assessment.
