

## Students are eligible for:

Reader Writer/Computer/Extra Time

- Sensory, physical or medical condition
- Specific learning disability that directly impacts on their ability to be assessed fairly for National Qualifications so that approved candidates can demonstrate their knowledge, skills and understanding, without providing unfair advantage over other candidates.
- Student's ability to read and spell is 2-3 years below their measured intellectual ability
- Student's difficulties in reading and /or producing written language prevent him from demonstrating his true intellectual ability
- Students must have this assistance every opportunity they can, so they are familiarised with the process

Our success rate in 2019 was 95 % of our boys passed NCEA, which shows how hard the boys work.

## **Learning Support**

Students are referred by previous schools, parents, teachers, self-referrals which then becomes our register.

Extension English where boys elect to not do a language and concentrate on English.

**Reading Plus** has a three -pronged approach using visual perception, comprehension, and vocabulary.

- ensures effective differentiation
- provides instructional scaffolding
- develops greater independence
- enables students to take responsibility for their own learning
