

Weekly Note Grade Criteria (Revised May 2021)

A student's progress in regard to his application and effort is assessed in each subject by the Weekly Note. Grades range from '5' (excellent effort) to '1' (most unsatisfactory). A '3' indicates a satisfactory effort.

What we see in a student who gains a 5

- Consistently involved in class showing enthusiasm, a positive attitude and application.
- Consistently completes homework and/or class work as befits his ability.
- Consistently follows classroom rules and instructions, participates, and has a positive impact on the learning environment.
- Consistently punctual for classes, and uniform is worn well and is appropriate.
- The appropriate gear and equipment are consistently brought to class.
- Uses their device responsibly and to enhance their learning.

What we see in a student who gains a 4

- Often shows enthusiasm, a positive attitude and application in class.
- Often completes homework and/or class work as befits his ability.
- Consistently follows classroom rules and instructions, and generally has a positive impact on the learning environment.
- Consistently punctual for classes, and uniform worn well and is appropriate.
- The appropriate gear and equipment are consistently brought to class.
- Uses their device effectively to support their learning.

What we see in a student who gains a 3

- Generally, does what is required and but shows a neutral attitude in class.
- Generally, fulfils the basic requirements of completing homework and/or class work.
- Usually follows classroom rules and instructions with neither a positive nor negative impact on the learning environment.
- Usually punctual for classes and uniform is generally worn well and is appropriate.
- The appropriate gear and equipment are usually brought to class.
- Generally, uses their device effectively and appropriately.

What we see in a student who gains a 2

- Often shows a reluctance to make the effort required in class.
- Inconsistent in completing homework and/or class work.
- Inconsistent in following classroom rules and instructions that can have a negative impact on the learning environment.
- Often late for classes and uniform is not up to standard.
- Often does not bring the correct gear and equipment to class.
- Often their device use is inappropriate, and this has an impact on their learning.

What we see in a student who gains a 1

- Poor behaviour and often shows no inclination to be involved in class activities.
- Often does not complete or show any reasonable attempt at homework and/or class work
- Consistently does not follow classroom rules and shows behaviour that is disruptive and inhibits the learning of others.
- Punctuality and uniform are frequently very poor.
- Often does not bring the correct gear and equipment to class.
- Does not use their device appropriately.
